Navigating the Nurse Licensure Compact:

Initial Licensure by Examination for New Graduates



Is your primary/legal state of residence (PSOR) a compact state? (This is the state in which you hold a driver's license, are registered to vote, and/or file federal income tax.)

Apply for state licensure by examination in any one state of choice.

Apply for licensure by examination in your primary state of residence (PSOR).

You may be eligible for a **multistate license**.

- » Pay your application fee.
- » Submit your state and federal criminal records check information.
