

ADULT SEPSIS CRITERIA	
SIRS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Temperature >38.3 or < 36.0 C Heart Rate (pulse) > 90 Respirations > 20 per minute WBC >12,000 or < 4,000 or >10% bands
Sepsis	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Known or suspected infection PLUS two or more SIRS criteria
Severe Sepsis (Sepsis PLUS New Organ Failure)	<p>Organ Failure Criteria</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> SBP < 90 or MAP <65 Acute respiratory failure as evidenced by a new need for invasive (e.g. intubation) or non-invasive (BiPAP) ventilation Creatinine > 2 Urine output < 0.5ml/kg/hour for 2 hrs. Bilirubin > 2 mg/dL Platelet count < 100,000 INR > 1.5 aPTT > 60 sec Lactate > 2 mmol/L Altered level of consciousness
Septic Shock	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Severe sepsis plus hypotension despite fluid bolus of 30ml/kg Lactate ≥ 4mmol/L

****severe sepsis presentation begins at the moment the last of the clinical criteria for severe sepsis are met or physician documentation of severe sepsis or septic shock ****
