

The Ohio First Steps for Healthy Babies Maternity Staff Training Program

Step 2: Train all health care staff in the skills necessary to implement this policy.

The Ohio First Steps for Healthy Babies Maternity Staff Training Program offers 8 free nursing continuing education contact hours upon successful completion of the online course available through <u>OhioTRAIN</u> (Course# 1079957). The online modules meet the objectives and content outlined in the <u>Baby-Friendly</u> <u>Hospital Initiative Guidelines and Evaluation Criteria</u> and can be applied toward the 20-hour training requirement.
