Part 2: Ohio First Steps for Healthy Babies Maternity Staff Training

Course Description

The training consists of 7 audio recorded sessions on OhioTRAIN. The training will help hospitals align their policies and practices to meet the goals of the Ohio First Steps for Healthy Babies initiative, and, if desired, applied towards the training requirements (Step 2) for hospitals seeking the World Health Organization's Baby-Friendly Hospital certification. The 7 modules from this course can be paired with the 15 modules from the Ohio First Steps for Healthy Babies Maternity Staff Training course (Course 1079957 on OhioTRAIN) to meet the 15 hours of required staff training for Step 2 of the *Ten Steps to Successful Breastfeeding*.

Following successful completion of the components of this blended series learning activity, the nurse will be able to demonstrate the knowledge to create a breastfeeding-supportive environment within his or her health care facility through implementation of the *Ten Steps to Successful Breastfeeding*.
